Daughter of well known theatre artist and classical singer Master Deenanath Mangeshkar, she started learning music from her father at a very early age. At the age of 8, she gave her first performance, in which, she sang Rag Khambavati, along with some songs from her father's musical plays and was v well appreciated. But she lost her father at a very early age and had to shoulder the responsibility of earning for her family. She started her career as a actress and singer in Master Vinayak's company, Navyug Pictures, at the age of 13, and while doing that, she got a break in a Sud production movie as

a playback singer. The year was 1947. That movie was never released but she soon got her first real break with the blessings of v well known music composer, Master Gulam Haider for the film ' Mahal' ...her song ' Aayega Anewala ', became a instant hit and a very memorable, golden chapter opened in the history of indian light / filmy music by the name--Lata Mangeshkar !. She has till date sung in 26 indian languages and holds a world record for singing largest no. of songs. She has also composed songs by the name of Anandghan ' . She has won many accolades, awards here and around d globe. She has completed 71 years of her singing career in October this year that is 2013. That is a achievement in itself!
